We will operate in compliance with all relevant environmental legislation, Official guidance and Industry's best practice.

It is our policy to:

- Comply with all current Environmental Legislation, Official Guidance and Local Rules at all times
- integrate the consideration of environmental concerns and impacts into our decision making and activities
- Plan all proposed work thoroughly in order to avoid waste, control emissions and conserve energy
- promote environmental awareness among our employees and encourage them to work in an environmentally responsible manner
- Recycle waste, whenever this is reasonably practicable.
- Actively seek to avoid the production of noise, smoke, vapours, fumes and manage any that are generated by use of extraction plant or insulation.
- Prevent the release of contaminants into sewers, drains, controlled waters or the aquifers
- Select for use, the 'Environmentally Approved' materials where there is an option.

- Manage the Special Waste in compliance with Legislation.
- Respect the Ecosystem, so as not to harm or interfere with animals, e.g. Badgers, Crayfish, Nesting Birds or Natterjack Toads.
- Report any or all incidents resulting in environmental Impact to the Client/Principal Contractor
- Arrange Training Courses which might be necessary to attend to maintain current knowledge of Environmental responsibilities.
- Review the Environmental Policy at least annually.
- Include the Environmental Policy and arrangements in all Induction Training.
- Make the Environmental Policy available to all interested parties.
